BOTH WERE AFFECTED BY HARVEY AS THE SCHOOL WAS FLOODED, AND THE DONATION WAS USED TO CLEAN UP AND REOPEN THE SCHOOL AND CONTINUE INSTRUCTION IN PIPING AND DANCE. WHILE IT IS COMMENDABLE THAT WE WERE ABLE TO REACH OUT TO HELP OUR FELLOW SCOTS, WE MUST ALSO LOOK WITHIN OUR OWN LIVING AREA FOR OPPORTUNITIES TO PROMOTE SCOTTISH ARTS AND HERITAGE. IN THAT VEIN THE SOCIETY FUNDED THE TROPHIES AND MEDALS FOR THE HIGHLAND DANCE COMPETITION AT THE 2017 HIGHLAND GAMES IN DAVENPORT. WE WILL CONTINUE TO LOOK FOR WAYS TO PROMOTE AND ASSIST IN INCREASING AWARENESS OF SCOTTISH HERITAGE IN OUR OWN HOME AREA.
